This is a leadership role, created for someone to take accountability of creating and rolling out a youth programme for Shia Islamic centres across the UK, the holder of this role will need to be charismatic, a positive role model for his fellow youth and highly driven.

Responsibilities & Tasks involved

- Attend monthly Central cabinet meeting/ and weekly Imamiyyah council conference call.
- Work with centre management committee, building trust and gaining their support for youth projects.
- Create a programme and plan to implement it.
- Arrange regular and wide range of youth engagement with Ulama across the UK.

- We require someone who can commit up to 5hours a week. (Weekdays after 6pm)
- Minimum commitment requested 12 months.
- Willing to travel to centres across the UK for meetings & events (reasonable expenses paid)
