Responsibilities & Tasks involved

- Attend monthly Central cabinet meeting/conference call.
- Visit all centres in your zone atleast twice a year.
- Motivate centre management to select coordinators locally.
- Mentor local coordinators.
- Promote Imammiyyah council initiatives in your region
- Establish region wide get-togethers annually to build a team spirit.
- Report on project success on monthly basis.

Time commitment:

- We require someone who can commit up to 5hours a week.
- Minimum commitment requested 12 months.
