Responsibilities & Tasks involved

- Attend monthly Central cabinet meeting/conference call.
- Motivate centre management and coordinators
- Create a programme to rollout scouts nationally.
- Promote the benefits of scouts, create a culture of Scouting.
- Train & create a guide on how to begin a scouts troop.

Time commitment:

- We require someone who can commit up to 5hours a week.
- Minimum commitment requested 12 months.

Skills & Experience

- Previous experience of scout leadership (reference required).
- Willing to have DBS vetting (upon successful selection)
- Can organise workshops, camps and more.
- Driver with car required, regular travelling, petrol fully reimbursed.

Performance Measurement:

- Quarterly performance review with Head of Imammiyyah Council
- Target to establish 1 scout troop in your region by end of 2018.
